

Squares of many colors-Scarf

Approx 8" X 60"

Materials: 4 50 g balls(each approx 109yd) of Noro (I used silk garden light)-any long sequence variegated yarn or use your scraps to make the squares (if you use scraps you will need 8 different colors that compliment your variegated yarn and three skeins of a variegated yarn)

Needles for yarn you are using

Gauge: Approx 18 st and 28 rows= 4 inches. Gauge not real important since it is a scarf

Before you start: For colors A and B use the variegated yarn and wind one skein into two equal size balls. For eight other colors (will label 1-8) cut 8 colors from one skein of yarn and wrap into balls or bobbins. (or use your scraps) You will have 2 more skeins to do the body of the scarf.

Borders of scarf are worked in seed stitch and body of scarf is stockinette st

Seed stitch: Row 1(RS)*K1,P1; rep from* to end. Row 2 Knit the P sts and purl the K sts. Rep row 2 for seed st.

With color A cast on 32 stitches. Work in seed st for 4 rows ending with a WS row.

Row 5(RS) With color A, work 4 sts in seed st, with color 1 Knit 12 sts, with color 2 knit 12sts then with color B work last 4 sts in seed stitch

Row 6(WS) With B work 4 sts in seed st then with color 2 Purl 12 sts, with color 1 purl 12 sts then color A 4 seed st

Row 7-repeat row 5

Row 8-repeat row 6 –in the squares knit on right side and purl on wrong side from now on

Row 9-12 Work 4 border sts color A in seed st then using color 1 work 4 sts, color 3 work 4 sts, color 1 work 4sts, color 2 work 4 sts, color 4 work 4 sts, color 2 work 4 sts work 4 border sts color B. Colors 1 and 2 will be the large squares and Colors 3and 4 will be the small squares

Row 13-16 repeat rows 5-8

Repeat rows 5-16 using Col 5 and 6 for the big squares and col 7 and 8 for the small ones. The borders remain the same

When you have completed the 4 large squares with 4 small squares in the middle, the body of the scarf is worked in stockinette st with the uncut skeins of variegated yarn continuing with the seed st border using color A on one side and color B on the other. When scarf is approx 55" repeat squares Using the colors of the small squares for the large ones and the colors for the large ones for the small. Finish with 4 rows of seed stitch with Color A. Bind off loosely.
